




Geografical Location Valencia

Valencia is located on Spain's eastern coast, at the mouth of the Turia River, right in the centre of the Gulf of Valencia. It is situated on the shores of the Mediterranean, a stretch of water which has gradually forged the city's character over the centuries. Valencia's geographical location makes it an excellent operational base from which to explore the rest of Spain.

At just an hour and a half from Madrid by train, three hours from Barcelona by car, and with daily departures to the Balearic Islands, the capital of the Mediterranean is well worth a visit. Bask in the city's pleasant climate, stroll along its wide sandy beaches, just fifteen minutes from the centre of Valencia, catch a glimpse of its past, sample the local cuisine and discover the richness of its culture.

Tourist Information

Kilometers and kilometers of beaches, hundreds of monuments, a thousand and one corners, millions of flavors to discover and a very long etcetera. The tourist offer in Valencia is as wide as it is varied and, furthermore, it continually reinvents itself so that you always have excuses to return.

It begins with a view of the **historic centre** and its rich artistic heritage. You can see the Holy Grail in the Cathedral; the **Silk Exchange** (Lonja de la seda), a jewel of civil Gothic; the **Central Market**, one of the most alive and appetizing in Europe; the ancient Roman ruins in the **Almoina Museum**, or go up to contemplate an unbeatable panoramic view of the city from the **Miguelete** or the **Torres de Serranos**.

Another must see, is the **City of Arts and Sciences**. We recommend you to combine it with a bike ride along the old course of the **River Turia**. The Turia Garden crosses the entire city, with the Cabecera Park and Bioparc at one end and the **City of Arts and Sciences** at the other, and more than eight kilometres of gardens to cover on your walk.

Also, you can't miss enjoying a good Paella by the beach. Nine kilometres of fine sand and a stone's throw from the centre. The beaches of València are waiting for you! You have the urban beaches of **El Cabañal** and **La Malvarrosa**, in the area of Poblados Marítimos, next to the famous neighbourhood of El Cabañal.

Information of interest

Valencia Airport:

8 km from the centre. Metro (lines 3 and 5), bus (line 150) or taxi (approx €20 for the journey)

Joaquin Sorolla AVE High Speed Train Station:

1 km from the centre. Metro (lines 1 and 5), free bus to the centre and taxi rank. Bus 64.

North Station (Station for short distance trains):

In the Centre: Metro (lines 3 and 5), bus (lines 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 14, 15, 19, 32, 35, 40, 63, 70, 71, 73, 81) and taxi rank

Port of Valencia:

5.5 km from the centre. Bus (lines 4, 30, 95) and taxi rank. Ferry trips to Ibiza, Mahón and Palma de Mallorca

Cruise Port:

6 km from the centre. There is an internal shuttle service at the port which takes passengers to the main terminal. Bus (lines 4, 30, 95) and taxi rank

Direct flights to Valencia



Valencia has an airport in Manises, eight kilometres to the west of the capital, with more than 50 flights.

Most airlines update their timetables: we recommend that you check their websites or ask a travel agent for the flights available for your planned date of travel.

Our flight connections include cities in Germany, Great Britain, Belgium, Denmark, the Netherlands, Italy, Morocco, Portugal, Russia, Switzerland and Turkey.

Championship venue


